

Design Work To Begin On Fuel Depot

The hiring of the Vetter Design Group for engineering design work on a replacement and redesign of the township fuel depot has been approved by Sylvania Township trustees. The old fuel pumps behind the township hall will be replaced with new pumps and a card-activated system for fueling.

Gregory Huffman, public works manager for the township, said the underground tank will not need replacing.

The township police department has its own fuel site at the police station, but all other township vehicles will get their fuel at the new site.

John Zeitler, township administrator, said it hasn't yet been determined if individual drivers will have cards needed to obtain fuel or cards will travel with the vehicles.

He added that a new pad and other changes to the site will likely be necessary as well and changes in the wiring for the modern pumps.

The contract with the firm, for engineering services for the bidding process and construction of the new fuel depot, is for \$9,400.
