Estate Jewelers, now on Monroe Street near downtown Sylvania, will be moving east near the start of the year to the 5400 block of Monroe Street in Sylvania Township.

Ed Szymanski, owner of the business, said he needs more space for his business and that a primary consideration for where he was going to move had to do the jurisdiction's police force.

He said he has always been satisfied his dealings with Sylvania City police, and he was looking for service which would equal or surpass it. In his experience and by reputation, he said the Sylvania Township police department matched what he was looking for.

Mr. Szymanski also noted that, with no income tax, there are advantages in moving his business to the township.

His new building has 4,300 sq. ft., compared to the current store's 3,000 sq. ft. A fair amount of the additional space will be used to expand his design studio for the design and creation of "one-of-a-kind" jewelry.

His business had been doing that kind of work for years, but this will give his designers a better and more efficient environment in which to work.

He also noted that just to his new store's west, Moona Market is under construction, and at the corner of Monroe and Whiteford, Genoa Bank has announced it will be building a branch office.

Also to the east, the shopping area where Target has dominated is undergoing a complete redevelopment.

He also complimented the township's zoning department.

"They asked for clarification on some of our plans, as they should have, but they treated us well," he added.
